

ALL that lot of land with improvements situate on the Southern side of Lermann Drive in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, shown and designated as Lot No. 13 on a plat of Section 2 of Fairfield Acres dated January, 1956, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book FF, Page 459 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Lermann Drive at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 13 and 14 and running along the Southern side of Lermann Drive S. 87-35 E., 80 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Lermann Drive with Paper Mill Road, the chord of which is S. 42-48 E., 28.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the Northwestern side of Paper Mill Road S. 36-41 W., 129.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 87-20 W., 27.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with the common line of Lots Nos. 13 and 14 N. 2-25 E., 126.6 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
