Mitchell, by my deed dated June 8, 1962 recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 699 Page 538. Subsequently on May 28, 1966 John S. (Sampey) Mitchell died testate and by the terms of his will which is on record in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, South Carolina in Apt. 945 File 18, he devised his interest in this property to the Grantor herein and name the said Grantor as Executrix giving her full power to sell and convey any property belonging to him.
