of this conveyance. as many times as he chooses by paying the standard tapping fee at the time
of the tap. and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line or lines, air vents, blow off connections, manholes and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line or lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line or lines all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger or interfere with the proper operation of or access to the same. It is understood and agreed that the right of way to be used under this contract during construction is to be 80 feet in width throughout the entire length which is approximately 51 feet, and the damage, which THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, is to be liable for during construction, is to be confined to this strip and nothing beyond. The location of the pipe line or lines, when laid, will determine the definite location of the right of way. The center of the pipe line or lines shall be accepted as ___ boundary line of this right of way. The remaining ___55__ S ... feet from the said right of way during construction shall lie N of the center of said pipe line or lines and the entire right of way may be used for the purpose of installing the pipe line or lines. The location of said pipe line or lines is to be approximately along the line as now located and staked out by the engineers, subject to a variation of not exceeding five feet either way. The permanent right of way, after the pipe line or lines are installed, shall be 80 feet in width measuring 25 South 55 North - feet from the center on each side of said pipe line as laid, and no obstruction shall hereafter be placed on said ____80 _ foot right of way.
