ALL OF MY RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST IN AND TO THE WITHIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

ALL of that tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in O'Neal Township on the northern side of Pine Log Ford Road and containing approximately 12 or 13 acres and being shown on the County Block Book as Sheet 499.1-1-30.4. This is the same property described in Deed Books 687, page 127; 654, page 187 and 204, page 356.

The purpose of this deed is to remove any cloud upon the title by reason of the language contained in the deed of David H. Styles to Arriabelle Lawrence, wherein the above described property was conveyed to her in Deed Book 204, page 356, wherein David H. Styles retained a life estate and apparently retained the right of sale.

David H. Styles died on July 23, 1958, leaving no widow but leaving four children, or their heirs, as follows: Charles Layton Styles, a son; Vennie S. Eaton, a daughter; Alice Benson Styles, a son who died on February 3, 1924, leaving a wife and children; and Arriabelle Styles Lawrence, a daughter, who died in 1954. Reference should be made to the other deeds of the other parties to be recorded of even date herewith, together with an affidavit of Calvin Brown.

Arriabelle Styles Lawrence died in 1954 as will appear in Apt. 642, file 33, leaving her husband, who died in 1955 as will appear in Apt. 642, file 32 and five children, Alice Mae Lawrence Reid (Grantee), Mary Ruth L. Riggi, Frankie L. Pitman and Samuel Benson Lawrence. Each of said children executed a deed for said property to Homer Styles in Deed Book 654, page 187 so that by deed recorded in Deed Book 687, page 127, Eugene Reid owns their interest. However, Larry Layton Lawrence was not of age when he signed the deed on May 15, 1959 to Homer Styles in Deed Book 654, page 187. This deed is to take care of his interest and his wife's.
