these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Lewis V. Wood, O.A. Wright and Palmer Covil, as Trustees of Hampton Heights Baptist Church, their Successors and Assigns in office forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in chick springs Township, Greenville

County State of South Carolina, on the south side of Lee Road near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots Nos. 7, 8, 9 and 10 on plat of property of James Edwards prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February, 1941, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an irm pin on the south side of Lee Road at corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11, and running thence along the south side of Lee Road, N. 73-44 E. 454.8 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 8, S. 13-07 E. 314 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-29 W. 450.4 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 11, and 13; N. 14-08 W. 301 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Lee Road, the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to Hampton Heights Baptist Church by deed of James M. Bruce, et al, dated October 16, 1950, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 421, at page 197, and by deed of Doris G. McKeithan, dated February 20, 1952, recorded in Deed Book 451, page 418, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. Lots Nos. 7 and 8 were conveyed to James M. Bruce, et al., as Trustees for the Missions Committee of Greenville County by deed recorded in Deed Book 396, page 479. The Trustees accepted this deed in fact on behalf of the Hampton Heights Baptist Church, the nucleus of which was organized at that time and in being.
