WHEREAS, on July-31, 1964, Nylon Industries, Inc., (now Fiber Industries) conveyed, without cost, to Greenville County a certain tract of land containing approximately 7.67 acres for the expressed purpose of the County using said land to construct and operate a sewage disposal plant to service Nylon Industries, Inc., (now Fiber Industries) and said deed provided that in the event the County ceased to use said premises for the stated purposes, the land would revert to the grantor.

It now appears that Fiber Industries, Inc. is paying for the construction of a sewage plant and intends to operate said plant itself or as a special service district.

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned members of the Greenville County Legislative Delegation, including the Senators, do hereby approve the transfer of said property from Greenville County to Fiber Industries at no cost to Fiber Industries and the County Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed from Greenville County to Fiber Industries.

Said Greenville County Delegation hereby further approves the County Board of Commissioners executing a bill of sale to Fiber Industries for the sewage disposal facilities that are now existing on the property in the sum of Two Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Four and 38/100 (\$247,204.38) Dollars.

The Greenville County Delegation including the Senators does hereby further approve the assignment and transfer of that certain contract of construction existing between Greenville County
