plat being prepared by the Engineering Department of the City of Greenville, dated March 6, 1967.

The area covered by this right of way is shown in red on the attached plat and begins on the Eastern side of Augusta Road and runs thence N. 70-32 E., 18.75 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Mauldin Road; thence with the right of way of Mauldin Road, N. 41-11 W., 43.00 feet to a nail; thence S. 64-00 W., 2.83 feet to a nail on Augusta Road; thence with said Road S. 19-28 E., 39 feet to the beginning.

The above plat shows work to be done for the channeling of vehicle traffic by the City of Greenville, S. C., or the South Carolina State Highway Department. It is agreed that there will be no concrete curbing, but in lieu thereof the channeling will be by painted lines and/or scattered stone adhering to the pavement by concrete or some other adhesive substance, and the scattered stone is not to extend more than two inches in height above the present roadway level:

S. C., its successors and assigns for street or roadway purposes, as a right of way or easement.
