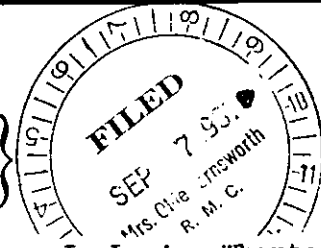

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Louise Wharton McLaughlin,

in consideration of One and no/100----- Dollars,
love and affection,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto James Dennis Shirley, his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Town ship, Greenville County, State Of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 3 on a plat of the lands of Mary E. Page as made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in May 1948, recorded in Plat Book "T", Page 46. Said lands lie in School District No. 160 and are described by courses, distances, metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South Side of Gordon Street Extension at joint corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3, which point is 213.7 feet in a Westernly direction from the intersection of Gordon Street Extension and Washington Avenue and runs thence S. 20-10 E., 153 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-28 W., 60 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 4; thence with the line of that lot N. 19-50 W., 142 feet to an iron pin on the South Side of Gordon Street Extension; thence along Gordon Street Extension N. 79-20 E., 60 feet to the BEGINNING corner.

This is the same property conveyed to M. T. Wharton by Myles Wright dated January 31, 1953, recorded in Deed Book 472, Page 21, R. M. C. Office For Greenville County.
