Key to Harry H. Jones, by deed dated January 11, 1929, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 148 of Deeds, page 8.

Also, a one-fourth undivided interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Augusta, Richmond County, Georgia, and more accurately described as beginning at a point in the Western boundary of Monte Sano Avenue, which is marked by a concrete pillar two hundred forty-one and nine-tenths (241.9) feet North of the intersection of the Western boundary of Monte Sano Avenue with the Northern boundary of Walton Way, thence extending in a general Westerly direction along the Northern boundary of the lands of D.
