THIS TRUST AGREEMENT, made this 14 day of May, 1964, by and between WILLIAM B. JONES, of Columbia County, Georgia, hereinafter referred to as Settlor, as party of the first part; and THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK & TRUST COMPANY OF AUGUSTA, in Augusta, Georgia, a national banking association, authorized to do a trust business, hereinafter referred to as Trustee, as party of the second part;

W I T N E S S E T H:

That the Settlor in consideration of the premises, and for the purpose of relieving himself of the management of property, does hereby transfer, assign and convey to the Trustee, IN TRUST NEVERTHELESS, all those securities and properties enumerated on the schedule hereto attached, marked Schedule "A", and made a part hereof, for the uses and trusts hereinafter specified.

I

The Trustee shall receive, preserve, manage, invest and reinvest said property, and shall pay the net income therefrom to the Settlor as directed from the date of this instrument for and during the term of his natural life.

II

Upon the death of Settlor, this trust shall terminate and the property then covered by this trust agreement shall revert to the estate of the Settlor and pass to his legal representatives.
