According to the records on file in our office, Mrs. Elzie Brooks Bullock was the wife of William Jackson Bullock.

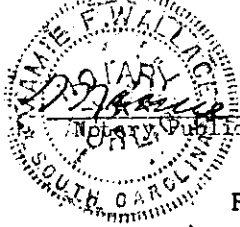
