PROCEDURE FOR DIVISION OF PROPERTY AS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH 4 OF TRUST AGREEMENT

- 1. Survey property to determine total area.
- 2. Locate line B parallel to line A so that part 1 is one-third of total area.
- 3. Rotate line D about point C until part 2 and part 3 are equal in area.
- 4. Point C shall be located at the intersection of Line E and the extension of Line F.
- 5. The property survey and location of division lines B, D and E shall be performed by a land surveyor licensed to practice in the state of South Carolina.
- 6. All costs of division of the property, including cost of property surveys, shall be borne by the grantor or grantors requesting division, unless otherwise agreed upon by all of the grantors.
