(iii) If there are boilers or pressure vessels, from boiler or pressure vessel explosion in an amount customarily carried in the case of similar industrial operations.

The term "full insurable value" means such value as shall be determined from time to time at the request of the County,

Lessee or Trustee (but not more frequently than once in every twenty-four (24) months) by one of the insurers selected by Lessee.

- . (b) At all times during the Lease Term, Lessee shall, at no cost or expense to the County, maintain or cause to be maintained:
  - (i) General public liability insurance, including Workmen's Compensation insurance, against claims for bodily injury or death occurring upon, in or about the Project, with such insurance to afford protection to the limits of not less than \$200,000 in respect of bodily injury of death to any one person and to the limit of not less than \$500,000 in respect of any one accident; and
  - (ii) Property damage insurance against claims for damage to property occurring upon, in or about the Project with such insurance to afford protection to the limit of not less than \$100,000 in respect of damage to the property of any one owner.
- (c) The insurance required by this Section 6.4 shall be maintained in full force and effect at all times during the Lease Term of this Agreement, except that such insurance required by
