All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Fairview Township, containing 183 acres, more or less, bounded on the west by Reedy River, on the north by the McPherson property, on the east by property formerly of Marion Harris, now of J. P. and Priscilla D. Woodside, and on the south by Jenkins Bridge Road as shown on a plat Priscilla D. Mac Richardson, February 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office prepared by J. Mac Richardson, February 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book X at Page 101 and as is more fully shown on a survey of property of T. D.
