in consideration of Eleven-Thousand Six Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$11,650.00) Dollars

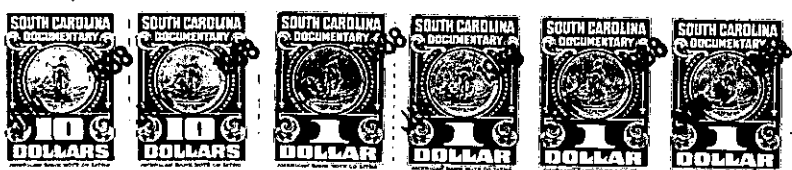
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto JAMES E. CRENSHAW, JR. AND BRENDA W. CRENSHAW, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings and improvements situate, lying and being on the Northern side of the Few's Bridge Road in Mountain View School District, Greenville County, South Carolina, near Mountain View School and South Carolina Highway No. 253, being shown on a plat of a lot for James E. Crenshaw, Jr., made by Terry T. Dill, RLS, dated April 9, 1968, and having according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of the Few's Bridge Road (said iron pin being located S. 89-45 E. 91 feet from an iron pin at the corner of property of James E. Crenshaw, Sr. and Mary Crenshaw and property now or formerly owned by E.L. Few), and running thence a new line through property owned by James E. Crenshaw, Sr. and Mary Crenshaw, N. 3-15 W., 175 feet to a new iron pin; thence continuing along said property, S. 89-45 E. 110 feet to a new iron pin; thence continuing along said property, S. 3-15 E., 175 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Few's Bridge Road; thence along the Northern side of Few's Bridge Road, N. 89-45 W., 110 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, this being a part of 20.3 acres, more or less, conveyed to James E.
