and assumption of mortgage
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto Louie E. Galloway and Virginia C. Galloway, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land lying on the southern side of Crosby Circle, in Greenville County, South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot No. 140 on plat of Paramount Park, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at page 57, and more particularly shown on plat of the property of Jerry C. Tuck and Carol M. Tuck prepared by R. K. Campbell, dated September 9, 1965, and according to said plat, described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Crosby Circle, at the front corner of Lot No. 141, which pin is 920 feet northwest of the intersection of Crosby Circle with Dorr Drive; and running thence with the southern side of Crosby Circle, N. 64-00 E. 70 feet to an iron pin at the front corner of Lot No. 139; thence S. 26-00 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-00 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-00 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 141; thence with the line of said lot, N. 26-00 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to restrictive covenants applicable to Paramount Park recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 389, page 251 and/or restrictive covenants applicable to said subdivision recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 404, page 479.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantors by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 782, page 03.

As part of the consideration of this conveyance the grantees assume and agree to pay the balance due on a mortgage to Cameron-Brown Company, the approximate balance now being \$8,360.00

together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee's(s') heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee's(s') heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
