to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Dan Beacham and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain parcel or lot of land containing 4.6 acres, more or less, situated on the west side of a County Road near Blue Ridge High School, Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being Lot No. 8 of the property of Hartwell Beacham Estate, according to survey and plat by W. N. Willis, Engineers, dated March 25, 1969, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail in the center of the County Road, iron pin on west bank at 20 feet, corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, and running thence along said road, S. 16-50 W. 111 feet and S. 31-10 W. 150 feet to a nail in the road, corner of the Dill land; thence along the Dill line, N. 70-21 W. 918.5 feet to an old iron pin on the Hightower line; thence along the Hightower line, N. 6-15 E. 173 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 7; thence along the line of Lot No. 7, S. 75-40 E. 983 feet to the beginning corner.
