


## LEASE OF A HOUSE

THIS AGREEMENT, made in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on January 11, 1969, by Wade and Rose June Thomas, Greenville, South Carolina, (herein called the "Landlord"), and Cordell Sullivan and Elouise Sullivan, Husband & Wife, Greenville, South Carolina (herein called the "Tenants"), WITNESSETH:

That the Landlord leases to the Tenants, and the Tenants hereby rent from the Landlord, a residence located at 100 Gates Street, City of Greenville, State of South Carolina for a term of one (1) year, from the 11th day of January, 1969, to be occupied as a private dwelling by the Tenants, and not otherwise, at the yearly rental of Thirteen Hundred (\$1300.00) Dollars, and the Tenants promises to pay in advance each week, during the term upon the conditions and covenants following: Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per week



- (2) That the Tenants shall at their own costs and expense, promise to:
  - (a) Take good care of the house and of its fixtures, and shall suffer no waste thereto;
  - (b) Make and execute all repairs required to the said house and to the plumbing works and pipes, furnace, range, and fixtures belonging thereto;
  - (c) Promptly execute and fulfill all of the ordinances of Landlord applicable to said premises, and all orders and requirements made, or imposed, by the Board of Health, the Fire Department, and the Police Department, for the correction, prevention, and abatement of nuisances, or other grievances in, upon, or connected with, the said premises, or the other grievances, and
- (3) That the Tenants:
  - (a) Shall not call upon the Landlord for any disbursements, or outlay, during the term hereby granted:
