KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that We, James Taylor and Ella Mae Taylor

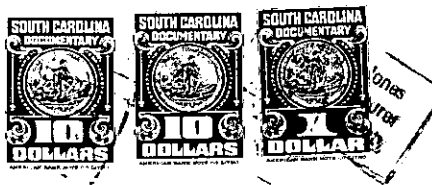
in consideration of Ten Thousand Five Hundred (\$10,500.00) Dollars,
