

All that certain piece, parcel and let of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aferesaid, on the Seutheast corner of McCall and Grace Streets, and having the fellowing mets and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin or a point on the Southeast corner of McCall and Grace Streets and running thence in a southeasterly direction with McCall Street Forty-nine (49) feet to an iron pin; thence in a northeasterly direction in a line practically parallel with Grace Street One hundred-ninety two & eight tenths (192.80 feet to an iron pin; thence in a northwesterly direction in a line parallel with McCall Street Forty-six & four tenths (46.4) feet to an iron pin on Grace Street; thence with Grace Street in a southwesterly direction One hundred-ninety-three & three tenths (193.3) feet to the beginning corner, being the same parcel andlet of land conveyed to me Charles P.
