It is hereby agreed that subsequent to a final decree of divorce, divorcing the parties each from the other, that the WIFE and minor children of the parties shall have the right to reside in said premises and make the same their home without hindrance or interference in any manner by the HUSBAND.

- 4. The HUSBAND agrees to convey and transfer to the WIFE, by good and sufficient instruments of conveyance, the 1956 Cadillac now in the possession of the WIFE, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever.
- 5. It is agreed that the summer residence in Lakemont Colony, South Carolina, which is owned by the HUSBAND and EMMA O. TARBERT, mother of the HUSBAND, shall be transferred, by good and sufficient Warranty Deed, from its present owners to the trust which was made and entered into on the 1st day of May, 1953, which said trust is known as the Denise Gail Tarbert, etc. Trust.

Said summer residence shall be held as an asset of the trust for the joint use and benefit of the beneficiaries of said trust.

This transfer shall be conditioned to allow the WIFE the free use of said summer residence during the months of June, July, August and September as a summer home for herself and the minor children of the marriage.

Nothing herein contained is to be construed to prevent reasonable personal occupancy by EMMA O. TARBERT jointly with the WIFE and minor children during the above mentioned months.

The HUSBAND shall have the individual right and privilege of the use of said summer residence, but in such a manner as not to disturb the use and enjoyment thereof by the WIFE and minor children during the above mentioned months.

6. That commencing with the first Friday following the entry of a final decree of divorce, divorcing the parties each
