

The HUSBAND further agrees to pay the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) to the WIFE, which said sum is to reimburse her for the employment of a detective in connection with the above styled divorce action.

The HUSBAND further agrees to assume and save the WIFE harmless from any and all obligations to L. J. CUSHMAN, ESQ., who acted as attorney for the WIFE during a portion of the above styled cause.

The HUSBAND further agrees to pay the attorneys' fees, for the WIFE, to the law firm of KELLY, PAIGE & BLACK, in the amount of ONE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,250.00), which said sum may be paid periodically with payments of not less than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) per month, commencing thirty (30) days after the date of the decree of divorce entered in the above styled cause. In connection with this obligation, the HUSBAND further agrees to sign a promissory note for said \$1,250.00, payable to Kelly, Paige & Black, in the usual and standard form currently in use in Dade County, Florida. Said promissory note shall include interest at six per cent (6%) on the unpaid balance, and shall provide for attorneys' fees and costs in the event that a suit for collection is necessary.

The HUSBAND further agrees to pay the necessary Court costs in connection with the institution and prosecution of the above styled cause. This will include the copy of the transcript of the deposition of the WIFE which was taken on the 10th day of October, 1958, and the reasonable cost of subpoenas and related charges in connection with the prosecution of the above styled cause.
