WHEREAS, The South Carolina State Highway Department pursuant to authority contained in Section 33-124, Gode of Laws of South Carolina, 1962, authorizing the release of the premises hereinbelow described, which premises are no longer required for purposes of the South Carolina State Highway Department,

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the eastern side of S. C. Route 291, lying between the 50 foot right of way for S. C. Route 291 and other property of the Grantee, and having according to a plat prepared by Carolina Engineering & Surveying Co., dated June 17, 1970, the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point located on the 50 foot right of way for S. C. Route 291, which point is approximately 313 feet North of the intersection of rights of way for S. C. Route 291 and the frontage road for Route I-385, and running thence along said right of way for S. C. Route 291 N9°-12'W for 135.9 feet, more or less, to a point, thence N80°-48'E for 70 feet to a point, thence S9°-12'E for 135.9 feet, more or less, to a point, thence S80°-48'W for 70 feet to point of beginning.

This being a portion of the property on which the South Carolina State Highway Department asserts ownership by a right of way easement dated October 10, 1938, from the E. S. Griffin Estate, which easement is recorded in the South Carolina State Highway Department.
