ALL MY RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST IN AND TO:

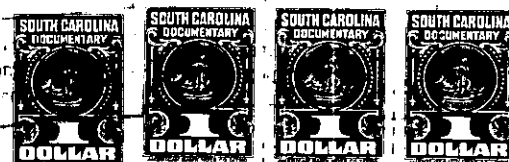
