ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southeastern side of Boling Court near the Town of Taylors, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 as shown on a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, dated September 26, 1967, entitled "Property of Williams Land Company near Taylors, S. C.", and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book VVV at page 67, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Boling Court at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 3 S. 36-52 E. 170 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-08 W. 90.4 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with the line of Lot No. 5 N. 36-52 W. 160 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Boling Court; thence with the Southeastern side of Boling Court N. 46-49 E. 91 feet to the point of beginning.
