Baker, Ansel Pruitt and Bill Byers, Trustees of the Greenville Baptist Association, Inc., their successors and assigns forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels and lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 3 and 4 as shown on a plat of property of the F. E. Harris Estate according to a plat made by W. D. Neves, Engineer, dated February 18, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C at Page 261 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the eastern side of Augusta Road at the intersection of Edwards Street, now known as Claussen Street, at the corner of Lot No. 4 and running thence along the eastern side of Augusta Road, 120 feet to a point at the corner of Lot 3 and an 11-foot alley; running thence along the southern side of the 11-foot alley, 141 feet to a point at the corner of Lots 3 and 23; running thence with the lines of Lots 3, 4 and 23, 114 feet to a point on the northern side of Edwards Street, now known as Claussen Street; running thence with the northern side of said Edwards Street, now known as Claussen Street, 182 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning;

Lot 3 was acquired by T. G. Moore by deed dated September 22, 1937 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 200 at page 88. Lot 4 was acquired by T. G. Moore by deed dated February 5, 1938, recorded in Deed Vol. 202 at page 27. Subsequently, T. G. Moore died intestate January 13, 1939 leaving as his sole heirs at law his widow, Elizabeth Moore, and his children, W. M. Moore, A. A. Moore, T. G. Moore, Jr. and Gladys Moore. By deed dated February 5, 1940, recorded in Deed Vol. 218 at page 238, W. M. Moore, T. G. Moore, Jr. and A. A. Moore conveyed their interest in said property to their mother, Elizabeth Moore, and by deed dated January 4, 1941, recorded in Deed Vol. 229, at page 313, Gladys E. Moore conveyed her interest in said property to Elizabeth Moore. Subsequently, Elizabeth Moore died intestate July 14, 1958, leaving as her sole heirs at law her son, Walter Marion Moore, son, Thomas George Moore, daughter, Gladys E. Moore, and granddaughter, Bobbi e Jeanne Moore Stewart, daughter of Albert A. Moore, whodied June 15, 1943. Subsequently, Walter Marion Moore died intes-

tate July 26, 1970, leaving as his sole heirs at law, his widow, Geraldine S. Moore, his brother, George Thomas Moore, his sister, Gladys Moore, and his neice, Bobble Jeanne * together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee (s) heirs or successors and assigns, to rever.
