these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WILLIE MAE HOWARD

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in \_\_\_\_\_ Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina all my right, title and interest, being a  
one-half undivided interest, in and to the following described  
property:

THAT LOT OF LAND located on what is now known as Timmons Drive, just  
off Airport Road, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina,  
according to a plat of "Airport Village Farms", Greenville County,  
S. C., recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S  
Page 161, on November 18, 1948, and being the south half of Lot 80-A  
and the entire Lot 81 and being more particularly described as  
follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Timmons Drive at the  
joint front corner of Lots 81-A and Lot 81 (which pin is exactly  
450 feet south of the intersection of Airport Road and Timmons Drive);  
thence N. 58-30 E. 200 feet along the joint front lines of Lots 81-A  
and 81 to an iron pin the joint rear corner of these lots; thence  
N. 31-30 W. 75 feet to a pin in the middle rear line of Lot 80-A;  
thence S. 58-30 W. 200 feet to Timmons Drive, the middle of the  
front line of Lot 80-A; thence along Timmons Drive S. 31-30 E. 75  
feet to an iron pin, the point of Beginning.
