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All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Cleveland Township, on the head waters of Mathews Creek, containing 560 acres, more or less, adjoining lands now or formerly of E. E. Stone and others and being a part of the O. P. Mills Estate purchased from the Estate of Guignard, the same being sold by Sheriff Gilreath, more fully described in a survey of the lands of the Estate of Guignard made by A. L. Hardin in 1899 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at Page 76; said tract being bounded on the north by tract known as "State Grant Tract", on the east by the Mary B. Pressley tract and on the south by the James B. Mayes tract and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances. to-wit:

BEGINNING at a pine tree located at the southeast boundary of this property at a point where the James B. Mayes and Porter Clark tracts coincide, the same being the south west boundary line of the Mary B.
