

***ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS CONCERNING EXPIRATION

This Power of Attorney is executed pursuant to the provisions of Section 47-115.1 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding any incapacity or incompetence on my part arising subsequent to the date of execution. In the case that I should become incapacitated or incompetent, or in the case that I should be officially declared to be missing in action, or to be a prisoner of war, to be detained by a foreign power against my will, all as evidenced by an official certificate given by authority of The Adjutant General of the Army (or other competent authority) hereto attached, this Power of Attorney shall continue in full force, effect and validity beyond the expiration date indicated on the reverse hereof, for an indefinite period of time, unless and until such condition as described shall no longer exist.
