ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying in Oaklawn Township State and County aforesaid, adjoining lands of C. J. Beacham and Major Watkins (now or formerly) and having the following courses and distance
REGINNING at stump on West side of dirt road, thence up said dirt road Richarder Frank Carder Frank Carder South South Carder C. J. Beacham; thence South along Major Watson line 460 feet to big Poplar tree at branch; thence following meanderings of said branch 300 feet to point of beginning, and being the same property conveyed to O. E. Holcombe by Willie R. Webb by deed dated the 20th day of June, 1953, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 480, at Page 361.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and situate in East-view School District, and having the following courses and distances:
