the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto C. E. Runion, his heirs and assigns forever

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina, on the Enoree River, and having according to plat made by W.
A. Christopher, Dec. 6th, 1916, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake marked B, on plat; thence S. 34 W. 10.67 to P.O.; thence S. 66½
W. 10.73 to P.O.; thence S. 42 W. 18.57 to stake on east bank of Enoree River; thence
up said river N. 77 W. 5.05 to Maple on east bank of said river; thence N. 41 W. 4.63
to Maple at bend of said river; thence N. 57½ E. 2.50 to W.O.; thence N. 46 W. 1.51 to
Birch; thence N. 23½ W. 1.77 to Ash; thence 27 E. 7.40 to Maple; thence N. 48 W. 3.62
to Ash; thence N. 1 E. 8.60 to stake near Birch; thence S. 80½ E. 1.75 to stone; thence
S. 9-¾ W. 5.60 to stone; thence N. 79-½ E. 35.05 to stake at beginning corner and containing
46 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of Cary Smith, Mrs. Dillard and others.
