KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. G. Cothran

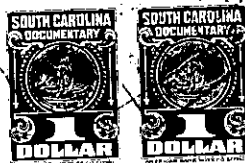
in consideration of Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100-----(\$750.00)----- Dollars,

unto Thomas A. Cothran, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the eastern side of a surface treated road containing 1.26 acres, more or less, and being known and designated as Lot A on a plat of "Property of J. G. Cothran" dated July 21, 1971, prepared by D. G. Casey, R.L.S., and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an X in the center of a county road at the joint front corner of Lots A & B and running thence along the center of said road N. 3-59 W. 127 feet to a point; thence continuing along the center of said road N. 19-35 W. 197.5 feet to an X in center of said road; thence S. 44-05 E. 153 feet to a stone; thence along a line of J. G. Cothran property S. 48-05 E. 286.3 feet to an iron pin; thence along a line of J. G. Cothran property S. 2-18 W. 171 feet to an iron pin; thence along a line of Lot B N. 57-09 W. 286 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is subject to existing easements, restrictions and rights-of-way upon or affecting said property.

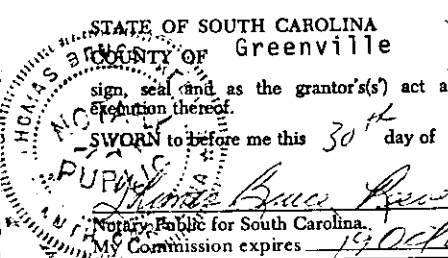

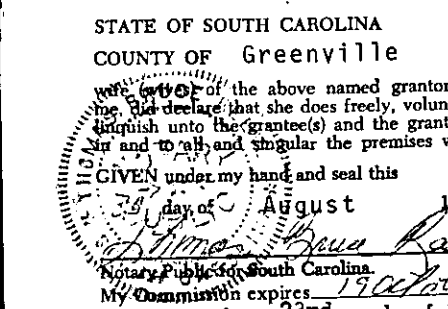
