in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 ----- (\$1.00) ----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

CLIFFORD N. WALLACE, Jr., His Heirs and Assigns Forever:

ALL of our undivided right, title and interest in and to:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Mauldin, Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 21 on a plat of "Addition to Knollwood Heights, Section 3," dated October 25, 1967, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book PPP at page 6, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the southeastern edge of Edgewood Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 21 and 22, and running thence along a line of Lot 22, S. 47-27 E. 164.55 feet to a point; thence N. 60-56 E. 37.25 feet to a point; thence along a line of Lot 49, N. 24-21 E. 84.00 feet to a point; thence along a line of Lot 20, N. 47-27 W. 150.00 feet to a point on the southeastern edge of Edgewood Drive; thence along the southeastern edge of said Drive S. 42-33 W. 115.00 Feet to the beginning corner.
