The right of way hereinafter described lies on both sides and crosses a permanent fifty (50') foot right of way heretofore granted to the City of Greenville, South Carolina, by deeds recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 392, Page 199, and Deed Book 392, Page 201, and shown on a plat recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Plat Book W, Page 81.

and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line or lines, air vents, blow off connections, manholes and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line or lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line or lines all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger or interfere with the proper operation of or access to the same.

It is understood and agreed that the right of way to be used under this contract is to be in such width and measuring from the center on each side of said pipe line as indicated on the sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof, and the damage, which the City of Greenville, South Carolina, is to be liable for during construction, is to be confined to this strip and nothing beyond. The location of the pipe line or lines, when laid, will determine the definite location of the right of way. The center of the pipe line or lines shall be accepted as lying in the position as indicated on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof. The entire right of way may be used for the purpose of installing the pipe line or lines. The location of said pipe line or lines is to be
