This permit is given subject to the following conditions (which shall be for the benefit of Bigelow):

- (1) That no sewer discharges (except from the property of Wallace) shall be permitted at the point at which the sewer line on the property of Wallace connects with the Sewer Line, nor shall any property other than the property of Wallace be permitted to connect with or discharge into the sewer line on the property of Wallace.
- (2) That the volume of sewerage from the property of Wallace to be discharged into the Sewer Line is presently approximately five thousand (5,000) gallons per day, and in no event shall the volume of such sewerage exceed seven thousand five hundred (7,500) gallons per day.
- (3) That the sewerage to be discharged into the Sewer Line from the property of Wallace shall be of such nature as not to damage the Sewer Line (or interfere with its proper operation) and shall, at all times, meet the requirements of any duly constituted legal body or authority having jurisdiction in such matters.
- (4) That Bigelow, at its option, may relocate the Sewer Line so long as the point at which the sewer line on the property of Wallace connects with the Sewer Line is not materially changed.
- (5) That at any time after six (6) months' written notice (or, in the event of the continuing violation of any of the provisions of this Permit, after ten days' written notice), Bigelow may terminate this Permit, (Continued on next page)
