QUITCLAIM DEED

Phillips, individually and as executrices and trustees under the will of William Martin, deceased, and Thomas L. Martin, their heirs, successors and assigns forever the following described property:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a portion of the southern one-half of West Coffee Street (as it formerly existed) and being shown and designated as Parcel "G" on a plat entitled "Survey for City of Greenville, S.C." dated December 23, 1971 by Campbell & Clarkson, Surveyors, Inc. and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point on the southern right-of-way of West Coffee Street (as it formerly existed) at the corner of property of Bill B.
