On the North by Hilltop Drive; on the East by Lot No. 18; and West by Lot No. 16 of the Raye E. McAlister Subdivision; and on the South by J. S. Garrett Subdivision, and being known and designated as Lot No. 17 on a Plat entitled, "A Subdivision for Raye E. McAlister" prepared by Pickell & Pickell Engineers, dated October 16, 1948, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book S, Page 153, and being more fully described by deed recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 910, Page 164.
