BEGINNING at a point in the northern line of the Loftis burial plot, and running thence in a northernly direction, along the grave side of James A. Cook, Gettie Cook, and of their two children, 19 feet and 2 inches, more or less, to a point; thence in an easternly direction 12 feet and 11 inches to a corner; thence in a southernly direction 19 feet and 2 inches to a corner in the northern line of the aforesaid Loftis burial plot, said distance being more or less; thence in a westernly direction along the northern line of the said Loftis burial plot 12 feet and eleven inches to the beginning corner.

The land being hereby conveyed is the vacant side of the Cook burial plot, purchased by James A. Cook and/or Gettie Cook from Mountain Creek Baptist Church about the year 1882, and acquired by Mattie Cook Reynolds and Henrietta Cook Black by reason of their being the sole surviving heirs of the said Cooks, that is, next of kin.
