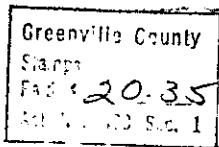
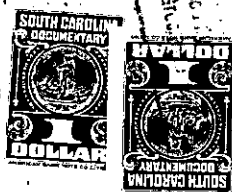
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, Roy G. Brown and Doris W. Brown,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release  
unto Donald Lee Easler, Sr. and Gail J. Easler, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 6 of a subdivision known as Farmington Acres, Section II, as shown on a plat thereof prepared by R. B. Bruce, Carolina Engineering & Surveying Co., dated July 21, 1965, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BBB, at Page 169, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Delray Circle, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 48-43 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the line of White Horse Heights Subdivision; thence along the line of that subdivision, N. 41-17 W. 130 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 7; thence along the line of that lot, N. 74-21 E. 150.2 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Delray Circle; thence along the western side of Delray Circle, following the curvature thereof, the chord being S. 53-02 E. 71.5 feet, to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by L. M. Brown by deed dated June 10, 1966 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 800, at Page 170.

This conveyance is made subject to any restrictions, reservations, zoning ordinances or easements that may appear of record, on the recorded plat (s), or on the premises.
