

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

LOUISE E. HARPER

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Sixteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and no/100ths (\$16,950.00)

to her

in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

JOSEPH E. NORRIS

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JOSEPH E. NORRIS, his heirs, and assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the Northern side of Wedgewood Avenue in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 22 as shown on plat entitled North Medow Heights dated February 22, 1951, prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "W" at Page 183 and having according to a more recent plat entitled the "property of Joseph E. Norris" dated June 21, 1972, prepared by Webb Surveying & Mapping Co., the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Wedgewood Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots 22 and 23 and running with the line of Lot 23 N. 27-46 W. 140 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 22, 23, and 24; thence running with the line of Lot No. 24 N. 41-02 E. 75.2 to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 24; thence with the line of Lot 21 S. 27-46 E. 167.2 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Wedgewood Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots 21 and 22; thence with the Northern side of Wedgewood Avenue S. 62-14 W. 70 feet to the point of beginning.

THIS is the identical property conveyed to George M. Harper, Jr. by deed of John Lude Vaughn dated September 1, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 507 at Page 239. The said George M. Harper, Jr. died testate on May 13, 1970 devising the property hereinabove described to the Grantor herein.
