DON G. NICHOLS AND MARGARET R. NICHOLS, THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER:

All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southwesterly side of Scuffletown Road, being shown and designated as a 16.2 acre tract on plat prepared by Carolina Surveying Co., 12 July 1972, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of Scuffletown Road at corner of property now or formerly of Alford and running thence with line of Alford, S. 33-00 W. 1161.6 feet to a point; running thence N. 68-45 W. 528 feet to a point; running thence N. 30-00 E. 1082.88 feet to corner of a 2 acre tract this date conveyed by the grantor to the grantees; thence with said tract S. 52-15 E. 300 feet to a point; thence continuing with said tract N. 30-00 E. 300 feet to a point in the center line of Scuffletown Road; thence with the center line of said Road, S. 41-00 E. .308 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

The within conveyance is subject to restrictions of record, and is also subject to utility easements and rights-of-way of record or on the ground, along with tap fees, set back lines, and zoning regulations.

This is a portion of the property heretofore conveyed to T. C. Connor and Lois M. Connor by deed recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 213, at Page 328. T. C. 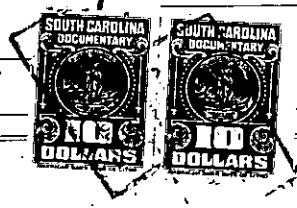
