closer than twenty-five feet to any front or side line of said lot, other than the rear lot line, provided the same does not face a street.

- 13. No vehicle of any type shall be parked on any lot for the purpose of making repairs to the same or stored other than emergency repairs by the owner of said lot, but no commercial repairs of any vehicle shall be allowed on said lots.
- 14. All residences shall have a standard letter-size, metal mail box as approved by the United States Postmaster General, which is to be erected by the owner on a 1 1/2 inch, glavanized iron pipe, at the height required by the United States Post Office Department. All boxes and posts shall be painted black and shall be kept in a good state of repair at all times.

These restrictions are hereby imposed by the undersigned, who is the owner of all the lots of the residential subdivision known as Ridgewood, a plat thereof being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Bood 4R, at Page 23.
