ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina containing 7.70 acres, more or less, according to a plat of survey of property of the L. A. Jones Estate prepared by Terry T. Dill, RLS, on November 21, 1967, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4-E at Page 161, and having the metes and bounds as shown on said plat, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Taylors Road at the intersection with Jones Road, and running thence along Jones Road N. 89-45 W. 969 feet to a point on a branch; thence along said branch as the line N. 24-00 E. 220 feet, more or less, to a point at the corner of Thomason and Vinson property; thence N. 43-45 E. 386.5 feet to a point; thence N. 50-25 E. 227 feet to the center of Taylors Road; thence along the center of Taylors Road as follows: S. 39-09 E. 95 feet; S. 32-45 E. 300 feet; S. 39-00 E. 174 feet; and S. 32-22 E. 197 feet to the point of beginning.

AS part of the consideration herein, the Grantee assumes and agrees to pay a certain mortgage in favor of The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 1165 at Page 17, upon which the present balance due is \$ 18,959.88

THIS conveyance is made subject to any and all restrictions or easements that may appear of record, on the recorded plat or on the premises.
