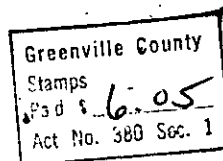
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that E. HENRY CAPPELMANN, JR. AND DOROTHY E. CAPPELMANN
