

There is expressly reserved to the Commissioners of Public Works the right to approve paving, grading, excavating, or other improvements to or on said right of way, and to approve the construction of any bridge or bridges across the North Saluda River separating the property of the parties; such approval shall be effective only upon the express written consent of the Commissioners of Public Works, or their authorized agent.

The grantor reserves unto itself, its successors and assigns, acting, however, solely through the Commissioners of Public Works, their successors and assigns, the right at the option of said Commissioners of Public Works to relocate the above described easement. In the event the Commissioners of Public Works require the relocation of said easement, any expenses of the relocation of said easement shall be borne by the grantees herein, their heirs and assigns, but said easement shall, in its new location, continue as an easement appurtenant to the land as set forth in this instrument for the benefit of Ray C. Roberts, Jr. and Alice M. Roberts, their heirs and assigns.
