- 11. This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their successors, executors, administrators, heirs and assigns. Words used herein in one gender shall be construed to include all genders.
- 12. The property subject to this Trust to be simultaneously conveyed with the recording of this instrument, is described as follows:

PARCEL #1: ALL that parcel or tract of land situated on the North side of Little Texas Road in Bates Township in Greenville County, S.
