All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate on the West side of the Miller Road (also known as Highway S 23-564), in County and State aforesaid, containing 0.90 of a acre, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at a Nail & Cap in said road and running thence N.75-35 W.357.7 feet to an Iron Pin, thence N.7-01 E.115.3 feet to an Iron Pin, thence S.77-06 E.302.1 feet to a Nail & Cap in said Miller Road (Iron Pin back on line at 30 feet), thence with said road S.15-30 E.141.1 feet to the beginning point. 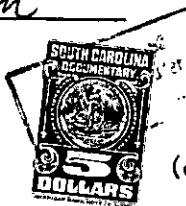
