ALL MY RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST (the same being one-half) IN AND TO:

ALL That piece, parcel or lot of land lying, situate and being on the corner of East Washington Street and Spring Street in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, said lot being shown and designated as Lot No. 6 upon plat recorded in the RMC Office of the Greenville County Courthouse in Plat Book C at Page 59, being the same lot conveyed to Willie H.
