

in consideration of the sum of Eight thousand and no/100ths-----(\$8,000.00). Dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. M. Cline, Sr., his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land on the southeastern side of Viola Street (formerly known as Parker Street) in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina being shown as Lot No. 14 of Block 3, Sheet 11 on the Greenville County Tax Maps and being further described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the southeastern side of Viola Street at the joint front corner of Lots 13 and 14 and running thence with Lot 13 in a southeasterly direction 51 feet more or less to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 14 and 16; thence with Lot 16 in a southwesterly direction 36 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 14 and 15; thence with Lot 15 in a northwesterly direction 51 feet to an iron pin on Viola Street; thence with said Street in a northeasterly direction 36 feet to the point of beginning.
