Coln and Tina B. Coln, their heirs and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and being known and designated as a part of Tract No. 2 of the Property of Pusman and Craft as shown on plat thereof made by W. J. Riddle, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the line of Property of W. L. Brown at a point 707.9 feet East of the center of Sulphur Springs Road, and running thence along the line of that property S.70-03 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence still along the line of the Brown property S.84-41 E. 1215 feet to an iron pin; thence S.44-05 W. 251 feet to an iron pin; thence N.19-16 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S.68-50 W. 365.4 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of his property N.84-30 W. 775.4 feet to a stake; at a point 735.1 feet East of the center of Sulphur Springs Rued; thence on a new line across said Tract No. 2, N.22-57 E. 216 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot contains 4.50 acres and is designated on a new survey made by W. J. Riddle on February 20, 1950 as Lot No. 2 of the Property of Albert M. Duncan and Christine E. Duncan.
